CHINA

The threat from arbitrary arrest and detention of Western businesspeople in China has increased significantly.

Since the arrest of Huawei CFO Meng Wanzhou in Vancouver on 1 December 2018, Chinese authorities have detained two Canadian citizens on allegations of undermining Chinese national security. The individuals have been denied legal representation and permitted very limited consular support.

Organisations sending travellers to China have a duty of care obligation to ensure their employees are protected by the highest standards of security provision.
